

Independent Child Trafficking Advocates Free Awareness Raising Workshop

Independent Child Trafficking Advocates (ICTAs) are specialist professionals who support children who have potentially been trafficked to navigate the complex systems of social care, immigration and criminal justice.

The ICTAs provision was trialled by Barnardo's in 2014 -2015 and we have now set up the ICTAs Service in three Early Adopter Sites across England and Wales; including all boroughs in Greater Manchester.

This means that all children identified as potentially trafficked within Greater Manchester must be referred into Barnardo's ICTAs Service
